

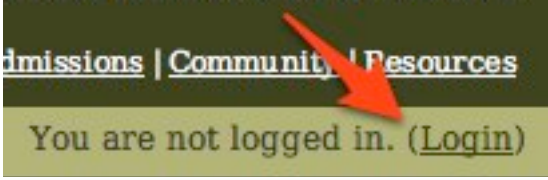
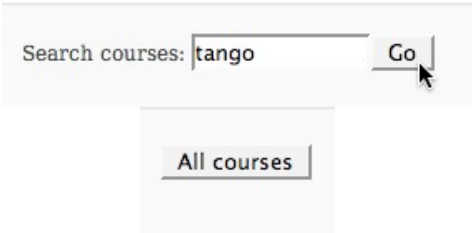

## How to . . . Enroll in a Course



When browsing/working within the Courses system [Firefox](#) is the best browser to use. Safari does not support all of the editing options available.



Please note that this does not officially (college registrar's database) enroll you in the class. Enrolling online simply allows access to the materials and discussions happening online.

<p>1. Start at <a href="https://courses.marlboro.edu/">https://courses.marlboro.edu/</a></p>	
<p>2. Click the small <b>Login</b> link located near the top right corner</p>	
<p>3. Enter your Marlboro username and password and click <b>Login</b></p>	
<p>4. Use the <b>Search courses</b> box at the bottom of the page and enter at least part of the course title. You can also click the <b>All courses</b> button and select the course from the resulting list.</p>	
<p>5. Click the course title</p>	

6. Click **Enroll me in this course** link under the administration heading on the left



7. Click **Yes**
